



## CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO: 12-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT, [IGA] BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON [CITY] AND PIMA COUNTY [COUNTY] FOR THE PROVISION OF ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES AND ENFORCEMENT OF THE CITY'S ANIMAL CODE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID IGA, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and the COUNTY are authorized to enter into this IGA pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-951 et. seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and the COUNTY have a longstanding continued contractual relationship since 2000 for the provision of animal control services; and

**WHEREAS**, the IGA contains a specific provision allowing the parties to renew for an additional term of two (2) years upon mutual agreement of the Parties; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of South Tucson and Pima County, desire to exercise the option contained in Article III of the Intergovernmental Agreement for Animal Control Services and renew the IGA for the period of two (2) years beginning July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties desire to have this item presented to the South Tucson Mayor and Council on August 6, 2012 at its next regular meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, all other provisions of the IGA not specifically revised by Amendment No. 1 remain unchanged; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to approve and adopt the IGA for Animal Control Services as presented; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure continued animal control services, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that the City hereby gives formal approval and authorization to the Mayor to execute said document

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption.
