RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE SECTION 8 MANAGEMENT ASSESSMENT PROGRAM (“SEMAP”) REPORT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2015 FOR THE HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (“HCV”) PROGRAM BY THE SOUTH TUCSON PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY (“PHA”) AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE STHA DIRECTOR TO SUBMIT SAME TO HUD

WHEREAS, the South Tucson Mayor and Council, on behalf of the South Tucson Housing Authority is required to review, approve and adopt the Public Housing Authority’s Section 8 Management Assessment Program (“SEMAP”) report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 for the Housing Choice Voucher (“HCV”) program; and

WHEREAS, the South Tucson Housing Authority is funded through the US Department of Housing and Urban Development and is required to submit the approval of the SEMAP report to HUD; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to approve and adopt the SEMAP report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 for the Housing Choice Voucher (“HCV”) program by the PHA; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson desire to have this item presented at its August 10, 2015 Council Meeting; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure timely submittal of the SEMAP report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 for the Housing Choice Voucher ("HCV") program to HUD, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that the City hereby formally approves and adopts the SEMAP report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 for the Housing Choice Voucher ("HCV") program by the PHA as presented.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption.
