**WHEREAS**, Cesar Chavez's birthday was established as a legal Holiday in the City of South Tucson Holiday in 2008.

**WHEREAS**, the City of South Tucson Mayor and City Council wish to amend and approve to establish Cesar Chavez Birthday as a legal Holiday as March 31<sup>st</sup> or the closest Monday and created specifically as a paid holiday; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chavez holiday celebrates the contributions and struggles of Latinos and immigrants and our communities' struggles for full equality and justice; and


**WHEREAS**, Cesar Chavez was a labor leader who represented and advocated for the hopes and aspirations of all working men and women; and
