



CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO: 12-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE TENTATIVE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON FOR THE 2012-2013 FISCAL YEAR, ADOPTING THE ESTIMATED AMOUNTS REQUIRED TO MEET THE PUBLIC EXPENSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF STATEMENTS AND SCHEDULES OF THE TENTATIVE BUDGET


WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Sections 17101, 17102, 17103 and 17104, ARS, the City Council did on June 26, 2012 make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real and personal property of the City of South Tucson, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the sums to be raised by primary taxation, as specified therein, do not in the aggregate amount exceed that amount as computed in A.R.S. Title 42, Section 17102.A, and

WHEREAS, that the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish, in the manner prescribed by law, the attached statements and schedules as said tentative budget, together with a copy of this Resolution, along with notice of the meetings of the City Council, for the purposes of conducting a public hearing when and where any citizen may appear and be heard or submit written comments in favor of or against any proposed use within the budget or the tax levy. The proposed budget may be examined on weekdays at 1601 South 6th Avenue, South Tucson, Arizona between 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the said estimates of revenues and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules in the amount of \$15,520,643 are hereby adopted as the Tentative Budget of the City of South Tucson for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

PASSED by the South Tucson City Council this 26th day of June, 2012.




