RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF PROJECTS FOR CONSIDERATION IN ARIZONA'S 2014 HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN:

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Highway Safety is seeking proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of South Tucson, through the Police Department, is interested in submitting projects to be considered for funding in the form of reimbursable grants from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of the submission of projects for consideration in Arizona's 2014 Highway Safety Plan is granted.
2. THAT the Chief of Police is appointed agent for the City of South Tucson to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.


