

CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO: 12-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING AMENDMENT 1 FOR CONTRACT NO: 01-70-S-143547-1010 TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CDBG) BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA (CITY) AND PIMA COUNTY (COUNTY) AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON TO EXECUTE SAID IGA AMENDMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, the **CITY** and the **COUNTY** entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement **COUNTY** for specific CDBG projects for the original contract for the contract amount of \$395,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the **CITY** and the **COUNTY** desire to approve and adopt IGA Amendment Number 1 to **Contract Number 01-70-S-143547-1010** to change the scope of the agreement providing that the **CITY** enter into a cooperative agreement with the **COUNTY** that provides for specific guidance, terms and conditions for the provision of Emergency Home Repair services and changing the termination date from December 31, 2011 to December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to have the matter presented to Mayor and Council at its June 26, 2012 meeting for the City's consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson have determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to enter into the IGA Amendment with Pima County; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that the City hereby gives formal approval and adoption of the IGA Amendment Number 1 and gives authorization for the execution of said IGA Amendment and empowers the Mayor of the City of South Tucson to execute said document.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage, adoption and filing with the Pima County Recorder.



WHEREAS, on December , 2010, the Board of Supervisors approved an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for \$395,000.00, consisting of federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, to CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON (CITY) to provide funding for management and implementation of the Community Development Block Grant Program described in the Project Summary attached as Exhibit A to original IGA, and

WHEREAS, the IGA expires on December 31, 2011 before the projects will be completed and IGA funds are not fully expended; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CITY desire to extend the IGA term in order to complete the remaining IGA activity; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development and Neighborhood Conservation Department has received CDBG funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to provide for CDBG projects in low and moderate income county communities; and

WHEREAS, CITY'S projects described in the Project Summary attached as Exhibit A to the original IGA are an appropriate use of CDBG funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

1. Article 2 – **Scope**, is amended to add Paragraph J to read as follows:

J. Enter into a cooperative agreement with County that provides specific guidance, terms and conditions for the provision of Emergency Home Repair services.


