Homicide

On May 9, 2013 South Tucson Police were dispatched to fight call at a residence in the 400 block of east 30th Street. Upon arrival officers located a Hispanic male victim suffering from multiple stab injuries. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene. The victim has not been identified.

The resident is cooperating with police and is being interviewed by detectives.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male possibly in his 30's, 6'02', 190 lbs, with a close/faded type haircut. The suspect has a scar and deformity on his head. The suspect also has a thin mustache.

The investigation is ongoing and additional information will be released as it becomes available.
