

The Duties and Responsibilities of a South Tucson Police Assist Team member are as follows:

* STPAT members shall perform duties as formulated by the Coordinator to fulfill the objectives and achieve the mission of the South Tucson Police Department. These Objectives include but are not limited to:

A. Provide the Police Department with additional powers of observation and recording of suspicious and criminal activity through supplemental patrol activities and fostering Neighborhood Watch programs throughout the country.

B. Provide citizens and businesses of South Tucson with usable tools, techniques and programs that increase personal and public safety and reduce criminal activity.

C. Provide assistance to Law enforcement and public safety officials during the investigations of collisions and crime scenes, as well as during natural disasters and other large scale operations.

D. Provide for the ongoing administrative processes of the STPAT including recruiting, training and maintain its own membership with support and assistance from the Department.

E. Provide public fingerprinting services to adults and children for a reasonable fee. Child fingerprinting shall not incur a fee unless authorized by a Corporate Board.

F. Represent the Department at designated public events.

G. Assist the Department in other areas as necessary.
