



## **RESOLUTION NO. 14-40**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, DESIGNATING THE ELECTION DATES AND PURPOSE OF A RECALL ELECTION; DESIGNATING THE DEADLINE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION AND DESIGNATING THE PLACE AND THE LAST DATE FOR CANDIDATES TO FILE NOMINATION PAPERS**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, as follows:

### **Section 1. Designation of Election Date; Purpose**

That **May 19, 2015** in accordance with A.R.S §§ 16-209 (A) (*If the officer against whom a petition is filed does not resign within five days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and other legal holidays, after the filing as determined pursuant to section 19-208.03, the order calling a special recall election shall be issued within fifteen days and shall be ordered to be held on the next following consolidated election date pursuant to section 16-204 that is ninety days or more after the order calling the election*), has been set as the time for holding the Recall Election in the City of South Tucson for the purpose of nominating candidates for City Council whose names shall appear on the ballot at the Special Election to be held on **May 19, 2015**; and any candidates receiving a majority of all the votes cast at the Special Election will be declared elected.

### **Section 2. Designation of Voter Registration**

Pima County registration and voting lists will be used for the municipal election. In order to be qualified to vote, an individual must be registered by Monday, April 20, 2015.

### **Section 3. Designating Date and Place to File Candidate Nomination Forms**

Candidates seeking municipal office may obtain nomination papers and other materials which must be filed by candidates at the City of South Tucson City Clerk's Office, 1601 South 6th Avenue beginning January 19, 2015. Candidates must file nomination papers and other nomination forms by 5:00 P.M. on February 19, 2015 at the City of South Tucson City Clerk's Office; 1601 South 6th Avenue in order for their names to appear on the Special Election ballot.
