

CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO. 13-33

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE SOUTH TUCSON POLICE DEPARTMENT (STPD), APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (AZDPS) ARIZONA GANGNET SYSTEM, CONTRACT NO. 2006-305 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, the AZDPS desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the South Tucson Police Department to establish a working understanding and responsibilities to and between the AZDPS and STPD relative to the connection and operation of the Arizona GangNet System and established policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the AZDPS is authorized and empowered to enter into this MOU pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1713.B3 and the STPD is authorized and empowered to enter this MOU pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 11-951, 11-954 et. seq.; 9-497, 9-499.01 and 38-511; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, as follows:

- Section 1. THAT approval of the AZDPS Contract #2006-305 is granted.
- Section 2. THAT the South Tucson Chief of Police is duly authorized to execute the MOU and submit all executed MOU in connection with such Contract.
- Section 3. THAT the MOU shall be in force and effect until terminated pursuant to the termination provisions contained therein.
- Section 4. THAT the South Tucson Chief of Police shall keep the Mayor and Council informed on a yearly basis as to the status of the participation with AZDPS relative to the MOU.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona.
