



**CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO: 13-23**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PIMA COUNTY ["COUNTY"] AND THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON ["CITY"] FOR THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.**

**WHEREAS**, County and City may contract for services and enter into agreements with one another for joint or cooperative action pursuant to A.R.S. § 11-951 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement ("the Agreement") to meet the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and subsequent amendments ("the Act") in order to obtain federal funding for the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG") and the HOME Investment Partnership Program ("HOME") for federal fiscal years 2014, 2015 and 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, County and City desire to engage in CDBG and HOME housing and community development activities as an "Urban County" as authorized under the Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") recommends that awards and expenditures of CDBG and HOME funds be made as an Urban County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City and the County to perform CDBG and HOME housing and community development activities jointly pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, it is mutually beneficial to both parties to execute the Agreement so that County, as a designated Urban County, may administer and execute the provisions the terms and conditions of the CDBG and HOME grants in accordance with local ordinances and State and Federal law.

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure timely approval, ratification and adoption of the AGREEMENT, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON**, that an emergency is hereby declared, thus the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption as follows:


1. The Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement between Pima County and the City of South Tucson for the Community Development Block Grant Program and Home Investment Partnership Program is hereby approved; and
2. The Mayor is hereby instructed and authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement for the Council of the City of South Tucson.
