



CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON RESOLUTION NO. 14-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, RATIFYING, APPROVING, AND ADOPTING THE FY 2014-2015 SERVICES AGREEMENT [“AGREEMENT”] FOR RECREATION PROGRAMMING, FACILITY AND FUNDING SERVICE BETWEEN THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA AS THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT RECIPIENT [“CITY”] AND PIO DECIMO CENTER, A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION [“AGENCY”] AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THIS RESOLUTION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON TO EXECUTE SAID “AGREEMENT” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, on or about June of 1987, the South Tucson Mayor and Council entered into a contractual agreement with Pima County for Recreation Programming and Funding Service to provide services to South Tucson Youth; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2001 the Parties continued their association pursuant to Resolution 2001-04 to continue the services to the youth of South Tucson; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2006 the Parties continued their association pursuant to Resolution 06-42 to continue the services to the youth of South Tucson; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2007 the Parties continued their association pursuant to Resolution 07-35 to continue the services to the youth of South Tucson; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2008 the Parties continued their association pursuant to Resolution 08-24 to continue the services to the youth of South Tucson; and

WHEREAS, the City of South Tucson has received CDBG One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000.00) for FY 2014-15 to continue to provide aid to the youth in engaging in crafts, organized games, and other forms of recreation at the John Valenzuela Center through Pio Decimo Center “AGENCY”.

WHEREAS, The City of South Tucson desires to have this item presented to the South Tucson Mayor and City Council at its next special meeting on October 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson have determined that it is in the best interest of the “CITY” and the youth in this community to enter into “AGREEMENT” with the “AGENCY” for the CDBG funding cycle of October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that the City hereby gives formal approval and ratification for the execution of said "AGREEMENT" and empowers the Mayor and/or the City Manager of the City of South Tucson to execute said document.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption.
