**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF SOUTH TUCSON CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THIS RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST**

**SECTION I.** That the Code of Conduct for Elected Officials, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, are hereby adopted and said copies are ordered to remain on file with the Office of the City Clerk .

**WHEREAS**, the South Tucson Mayor and Council, operate under a Council-Manager form of government and

**WHEREAS**, the City of South Tucson Mayor and Council are subject to the limitations imposed by the State Constitution and so long as the State law, all powers are vested in the elected City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council which is comprised of six council and the Mayor; enacts local legislation, adopts budgets, determines policies, appoints City Manager, City Magistrate and City Attorney; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson desires to have this item presented at its December 12, 2014 Council Meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that an emergency be declared to exist to assure timely adoption of the City of South Tucson Code of Conduct for Elected Officials, and that this Resolution be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that the City hereby formally approves and adopts the City of South Tucson Code of Conduct for Elected Officials as presented.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, that, due to an existing emergency declared herein, the immediate effectiveness of this Resolution is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and safety of the City of South Tucson, Arizona, and this Resolution shall therefore be effective upon its passage and adoption.
